English Language Teaching

From 2006 until 2009 LSI project managed and staffed three state of the art training centres for our Saudi partners in Jubail as well as remote training projects in Khobar and Yanbu.

During this period the training project employed between 25 and 30 full time expatriate English language instructors at any one time and delivered over 75,000 hours of teacher led English training to students working within the Oil and Gas industry. Clients included Saudi Aramco, SABIC, Saudi Kayan, ADC, Tasnee, Royal Commission of Yanbu and Jubail, APPC, Ar-razi, GAS, Gulf Farabi, Hadeed, Petrokeyma, Sabtank, Saudi Chevron, United and United Gulf Steel.

Examples of some of the key training programmes included:

- Preferred vendor status for SABIC Shared Services and SABIC Career Development delivering 180 hour English courses to over 500 SABIC employees.
- Delivering a 6-month (720 hour) intensive Foundation English training programme to 250 Saudi Kayan trainees

In addition to English language training the project also included integration of English language training into a range of Technical Training and HSE training programmes delivered by the academy.



International Assessment Services

LSI set up an authorised University of Cambridge Examination centre (SA024) in Jubail offering a broad suite of Cambridge ESOL examinations. The centre also trained a team of international Cambridge Speaking examiners.

LSI is also an authorised BULATS agent and delivered BULATS exams to clients throughout the Kingdom such as the Royal Commission. We also delivered BULATS assessments to employees within Saudi Aramco allowing the creation of a benchmark for ensuring success in overseas training programmes delivered in English.

Teacher Training

LSI has experience delivering professional development training to Saudi teachers. A flagship project was including training 25 English teachers from schools within the Jubail Royal Commission. These teachers received a 90-hour training programme cumulating in a 100% success rate in passing the University of Cambridge Teaching Knowledge Test (TKT) for modules 1 - 3. KPI Feedback for the Royal Commission had overall ratings for the programme and teacher trainers at over 95%.

LSI also ran a range of bespoke professional development workshops for trainers within the Oil and Gas industry including a hugely successful 5-day Train the Trainer course for non-native speaking Health and Safety professionals.
